

ELY CAR PARKING Explaining the new Off-Street Parking Arrangements

Short Stav

- 1. Brays Lane Remains a 2-hour car park
- 2. Forehill New 4 hour parking
- 3. St Mary's Street Remains a 2-hour car park (more spaces coming soon)
- 4. The Grange, Nutholt Lane Saturday 3-hour car park
- 5. Newnham Street (Short Stay Section) – remains a 3-hour car park.

Long-Stay



with early morning restrictions* in the following car parks

- 6. Barton Road (Cathedral)
- 7. Fisherman's car park
- 8. Newnham Street (Long Stay section)
- 9. Ship Lane

*90 minutes parking between 8:00 and 10:00am with no return for 2 hours Unrestricted outside these times - Applicable Monday to Saturday. i.e. If you are parked at 8:00am you need to remove your vehicle by 9:30, if you arrive at 8:31am you can stay all day.

New Long Stay Pay & Display Angel Drove

- Angel Drove Location close to the Railway Station
- 205 spaces
- Charges:

£2.50 per day £11.00 per week

Park and Ride operating every Saturday from the bus stop at Tesco's.
